As most Villagers are aware, the Executive Board of the Association has been continuing to evaluate potential Fourth of July activities. Under recent pronouncements, the governor has left the decision about allowing parades to take place up to local municipalities. On Friday, June 4, we were notified that the Town has approved our holding a parade in Cotuit.

We remain very concerned for overall safety. Some communities have decided not to hold any events for the time being, until later in the summer. We are especially worried because our Parade usually draws as many as 14,000 people to Village streets. But we also recognize the desire of many to have at least some events celebrating the 4th this year as a part of returning to some sense of normalcy. So, we have decided to hold a limited parade this year – no bands, floats or walking groups. We will have antique cars and bikes, all to be decorated with a Fourth of July theme. And nothing is to be thrown into those along the Parade route!! Bikers should assemble at the Post Office parking lot, and will come after the antique cars. We will post application papers for the antique cars to our web site in the coming days. Details are still being worked out – they will be posted to our web site soon. We are most anxious to keep this as a Cotuit only event, and do not plan to do any promotion. We are counting on all Villagers to do the same.

We have also planned a special photo event for the weekend to provide another celebration. We will have photo sessions at Ropes Beach on Friday, July 2 and Saturday, July 3, from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m., as part of the kite festival. Again, details are still being worked out and will be communicated shortly.

We will have a meeting on Monday, June 21, starting at 7:30 p.m., at which the Cotuit Federated Church will present their building expansion plans. The meeting will be held at Freedom Hall. You can also participate on Zoom. To join by Zoom, use the following information;
